

Tips for Centre County PA Voter Registration (or Changes to a PA Voter Registration)

Forms are available at post offices and from the Office of Elections

(420 Holmes St., Bellefonte, PA 16823)

Your application will be declined if it is incomplete or if it cannot be read.

IMPORTANT: Use a black pen and write legibly. Fill out the form completely.

1. NAME: Required, EXACTLY as it appears on your PA driver's license/PA Id., or your Social Security card.

2. ELIGIBILITY: Required. Check the two that apply.

You must be 18 years old, a U.S. citizen, a resident of PA, and live in your election district for at least 30 days before the next election.

3. REASON: Required. Check new registration if you are a new voter in Centre County or select the appropriate option.

4. ABOUT YOU: Required.

Your registration cannot be processed without your birth date.

Provide a phone number and email so that the Office of Elections can contact you to resolve issues that would prevent your voter registration from being approved.

5. YOUR ADDRESS: Required. Provide your PHYSICAL ADDRESS in Centre County, not your P.O. Box.

This address will determine where you vote and who is on your ballot.

No address? Pinpoint your location on the map provided on the back of the form.

If your mailing address differs from the physical address listed, complete #6.

6. MAILING ADDRESS: Required if your MAILING ADDRESS is different than the address listed in #5.

7. IDENTIFICATION: Required.

Provide your PA Dept of Transportation number (license or ID) **OR** the last four digits of your Social Security Number.

8. POLITICAL PARTY: Required.

To cast a ballot in a primary election, a voter must be registered as a Democrat or Republican.

Party affiliation is not required to vote in a municipal or general election.

9. VOTING ASSISTANCE: If needed. Check the appropriate box.

10. NAME or ADDRESS CHANGE: If needed. Essential if you were registered in another state or PA county.

Leave blank if this is your first registration.

11. DECLARATION: Required. Read it and sign your name as it appears on legal documents. You will be asked to replicate this signature every time you vote.

Neatly print your name and today's date.
